3. Does the ghostwriter understand where you are coming from? Can you communicate with them effectively and do you get a sense that they are on the same page as you?
4. Does the ghostwriter have a writing style that is in alignment with what you intend your story to feel like? It's no good to enlist the service of ghostwriter to write a horror novel when they are clearly more suited to writing romantic prose.
5. Can this person help you edit and organize your notes and thoughts? Do they have what it takes to put all that you have together and create a substantial publication?
6. Finally, can they ideally spend some time with you nutting out your specific requirements? Are they receptive to hearing your hopes and dreams on the projects and do you feel like they 'get' you?

It's important that no matter the ghostwriter you're dealing with that you interview them extensively and that you both seem to get along. It's important that you do, as you will be in this project together for a while.
